

## CIA Student Verse Sheet and Live-it-Out

Each verse can be recited two times. One point each time. Live it out can be done and submitted for one point for each lesson.

Unit 1 <b>1</b>	<b>Revelation 4:11</b> - You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor, and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being.	Revelation 4:11 says, you are worthy, our Lord and God to receive glory and honor, and power... Make a list of things in creation that you are grateful for. Write a prayer thanking God for His goodness.
<b>2</b>	<b>Psalms 77:14</b> - You are the God who performs miracles; you display your power among the peoples.	Read Exodus 7 through 11. Make a list of the plagues God sent to persuade Pharaoh to let the Israelites leave and what was Pharaoh's reaction?
<b>3</b>	<b>Philippians 4:19</b> - And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus.	Read Philippians 4:19-And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus. Make a list of things God supplies for you each and every day. Thank Him for all He does for you.
Unit 2 <b>4</b>	<b>Psalms 24:8</b> - Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.	This week I want you to think about a situation that you think is impossible. Write it down then pray continuously and ask God to give you guidance and answers. Record your answer and bring it to CIA.
<b>5</b>	<b>Psalms 66:3</b> - Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! So great is your power that your enemies cringe before you."	Make a list of the situations where we saw God display his power in our lessons. How many times did the people call out to God <b>after</b> they were in trouble? Thank God for His power.
<b>6</b>	<b>Colossians 1:29</b> - To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me.	Read our lesson verse- Colossians 1:29 Make a list of some ways you can use the energy God gives to you to make a difference. Pray and ask God what He wants you to do today.
Unit 3 <b>7</b>	<b>Isaiah 41:10</b> - So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.	Our verse reminds us not to fear because God is with us. Using a blank piece of paper and a pencil, write a list of fears. Take a marker and boldly write our verse in large letters, covering your list of fears. Pray and ask God to take your fears away.
<b>8</b>	<b>Ephesians 3:20</b> - Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us.	Write out a list of things God provides for you in a given week. How does God provide for these needs? Write a thank you letter to God for meeting your needs. Memorize the verse for the lesson.
<b>9</b>	<b>1 Kings 18:39</b> - When all the people saw this, they fell prostrate and cried, "The LORD- He is God! The LORD- He is God!"	Elijah felt like he was the only one following God. This week, I want you to bow down and worship God each day, repeating the above verse. Also invite 2 friends to join you in CIA so they can learn to who God is.
Christmas <b>10</b>	<b>Luke 2:20</b> - The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.	God gave us the greatest gift ever, Jesus. When the shepherds visited Jesus, they went out and told others the news. Read our lesson verse. Share the Good News of Jesus someone this week. Pray they will let you share. Write down their name and how they reacted to the message.

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Unit 4 <b>12</b>	<b>Psalm 78:4</b> – We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD, His power, and the wonders He has done.	Write two or more paragraphs about something you have seen God do for you or your family, how He has answered prayer or shown His power. Share your story with 2 people.
<b>13</b>	<b>I Corinthians 2:5</b> – so that your faith might not rest on human wisdom, but on God’s power.	Make a list of 5 people you want to share your faith with. Pray and ask God to help you tell them about Jesus. Read our verse I Corinthians 2:5 and accept God’s power.
<b>14</b>	<b>Daniel 3:17</b> - If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and he will deliver us from Your Majesty’s hand.	Our verse this week is a little more challenging but God is able to deliver you from the doubt that says it is too hard. In addition to memorizing the verse, I want you to write down one area that God has delivered you from the enemy?
Unit 5 <b>15</b>	<b>Daniel 6:27</b> - He (God) rescues and He saves; He performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on earth. He has rescued Daniel from the power of the lions.	Read Daniel 6. Write out verses 26-27. Read all the great things King Darius said about our living God. Make a list of the great things God does for us.
<b>16</b>	<b>Romans 10:13</b> - for Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.	Take a few minutes right now and call out to God in prayer. Our verse for today says, “ for Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.” Have you called out to the LORD for salvation? Make this the day that you begin a relationship with Jesus and become a Christian. Write out a prayer.
<b>17</b>	<b>John 6:14</b> - After the people saw the sign Jesus performed, they began to say, “Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world.”	Take a look through Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. Make a list of miracles where Jesus showed His power. Write a summary of your favorite miracle and why.
Unit 6 <b>18</b>	<b>John 20:30</b> - Jesus performed many other miraculous signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not recorded in this book.	Jesus did many miracles. He did these to bring Glory to God. What miracle have you seen God do in your life or in the life of a friend? Write down what miracle you would like to see God perform. Write a thank you note to God.
<b>19</b>	<b>Ephesians 3:7</b> - I became a servant of this gospel by the gift of God’s grace given me through the working of His power.	Read Acts 9 about Paul’s life changing experience. Make a list of five people you know who try to live a good life but don’t have a relationship with Jesus. Begin praying for them. Share Jesus with them. Write down what happened when you shared the Good News.
<b>20</b>	<b>John 5:24</b> - “Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life.	Read Acts 26. Write a summary of how God got his attention. List who Paul shared the message of Jesus with. Read Acts 26:18. Write down what God told Paul to do. The list should include 5 steps.
Easter <b>21</b>	<b>Acts 2:24</b> - But God raised Him from the dead, freeing Him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on Him.	Read Matthew 27-28. Make a list of important events that happened in these chapter. This should include ways that Jesus suffered to pay for our sin. Write a thank you letter to Jesus thanking Him for paying for your sin.
