The Bible teaches that God's Word and people's souls last. Mentoring a student through the Barnabas program is a way of investing your life into those two eternal things. Consider 1 Thessalonians 2:8: "We loved you so much that we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well, because you had become so dear to us."

Paul was saying that because he loved the Thessalonians, he invested in them not just God's message, but his life also. Students today need that kind of input just as much as the early church did. Through the Barnabas program you can motivate a teen toward growth, love, and good deeds (see Hebrews 10:24,25). You will share your life and wisdom with the next generation.



What is the Barnabas Program?

Each student enrolled in Joy El's 4.12
Leadership Training Program commits to the pursuit of knowing and sharing Christ in several ways. Part of their commitment involves Bible reading, Scripture memorization, developing a prayer life, serving others, etc. We also ask each student to recruit a local mentor.

We realize that we can provide a wonderful program for students who want to grow, but each student could benefit so much more from having a spiritual and personal coach walking alongside him/her in this journey of faith.

As a mentor, you will get to know your student individually. You will recognize strengths and weaknesses. You will hear how s/he is growing and what God is teaching him/her. You will be the one who can take general program requirements and help a student see the relevance to his/her life.

Our desire is for these relationships to transcend the Joy El connection and impact your churches, encouraging others as they see the Titus 2:4-8 mandate to teach the younger generation demonstrated in real life.

What is expected of me?

- Receive Barnabas Mentor training, either at Joy El or through a training workbook provided for you.

- You will be invited to other trainings and events. These are optional, but valuable.
- Start on the required background checks.
