<b>Psalm 119:105 - Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.</b> The Bible lights the way for us and shows us how to live.														
<b>Genesis 1:31 - God saw all that he had made, and it was very good.</b> <b>And there was evening, and there was morning- the sixth day.</b> God looked at everything He made. He saw that everything He made was good. This was the sixth day of creation.														
<b>Romans 3:23- For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,</b> We all sin. We do things we shouldn't do. We are not perfect. We miss God's goals and His glory.														
<b>Step Into Action: Complete the action and have a parent sign each unit.</b> Unit 1: Read Genesis 1. Count how many times God says, "It is very good".														
<b>Unit 2 – Unit verses may ONLY be said in unit weeks.</b>														
<b>John 1:12- Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.</b> When we believe in Jesus and ask Him to be our Savior, we become God's child.														
<b>Mark 16:15 - He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.</b> Jesus gave instructions to go into the world and tell people everywhere the Good News about Himself.														
<b>Ephesians 2:10- For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.</b> We are made by God. He already has plans for us to do good things.														
<b>Step Into Action: Complete the action and have a parent sign each unit.</b> Unit 2: Make a list of 5 people who need to hear the "Good News". Pray for them and then share the "Good News" with them.														
<b>Unit 3– Unit verses may ONLY be said in unit weeks.</b>														
<b>Romans 12:12- Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.</b> Be joyful as you keep hoping. While you are having trouble, be patient and keep praying about your situation.														
<b>Joshua 1:9b- ...Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go."</b> God tells us to be strong and courageous. We shouldn't be afraid or discouraged because God is always with us.														
<b>Ephesians 4:32- Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.</b> We need to be kind and caring to each other. We need to forgive others when they do wrong to us because Christ forgives us.														
<b>Step Into Action: Complete the action and have a parent sign each unit.</b> Unit 3: Read Ephesians 4:32. Tell your parents about a time when you forgave someone.

	<b>Psalm 23:4</b> Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
	<b>Psalm 23:5</b> You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.
